Your debate partners are counting on you to commit fully. Listed below are the non-negotiable conditions for any debate team member:

- 1. You will do all the work assigned to you by the coaches. Work will consist of research, constructing cases, and brief assignments to strengthen fundamental debate skills.
- 2. You will show up to all the debate meetings, or you will not be allowed to go the debate tournaments. Valid excuses for missing a debate meeting are illness that prevented you from going to school that day, a family emergency, or a previous commitment made before the creation of the debate team.
- 3. You must attend the debate tournaments. Valid excuses for missing a tournament are the same as above and notice must be given to your teacher/coach.
- 4. You will be entirely respectful when someone else is speaking, be it a coach, or another debater. This means sitting still, remaining silent until the person speaking is done, and not moving papers, pencils, etc.
